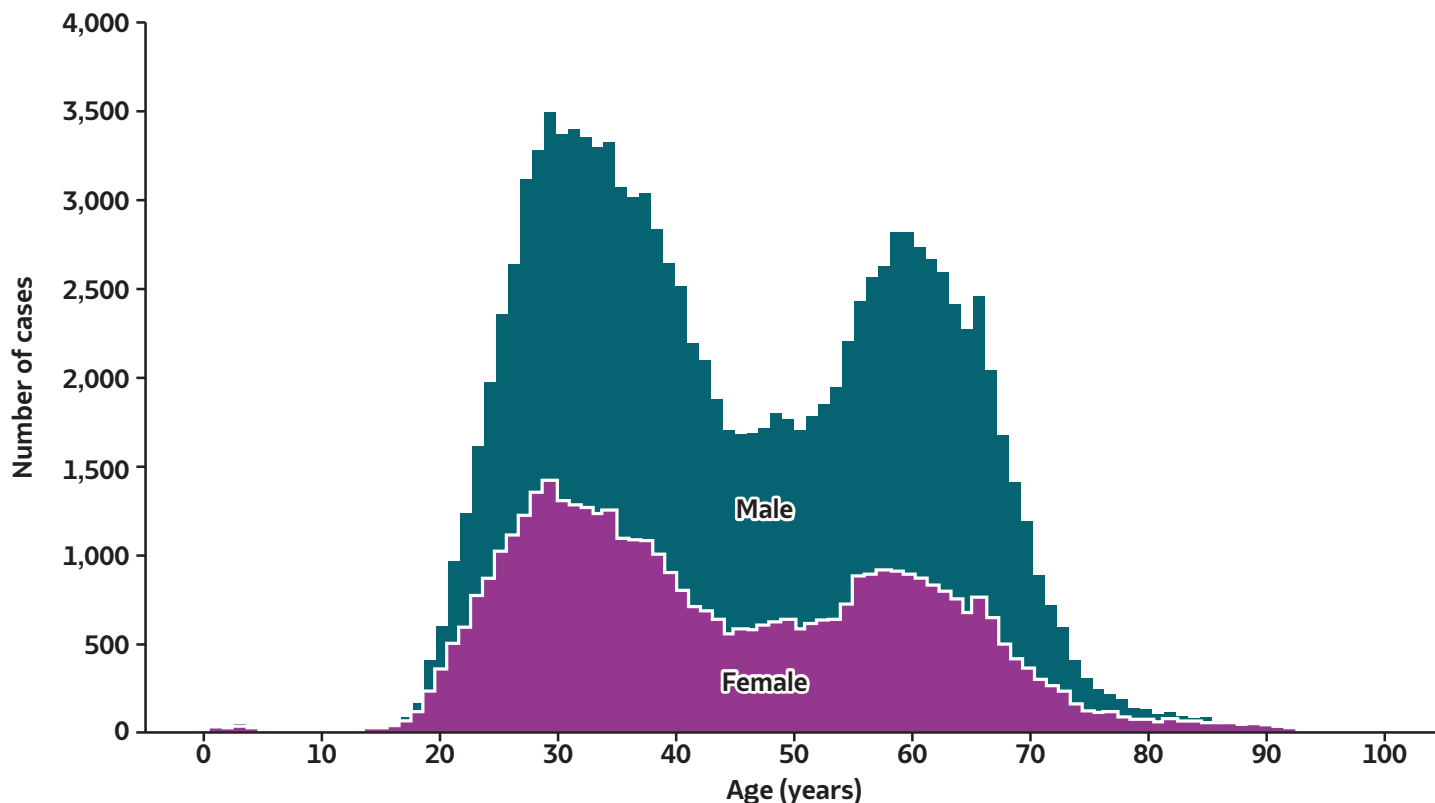


Figure 3.8. Number of newly reported* chronic hepatitis C virus infection cases†, by sex and age — United States, 2019
