

General Health Questionnaire (GHQ)

Description

GHQ-30 is a self-report screening instrument to detect current, diagnosable psychiatric disorders. It includes especially an assessment of the inability to carry out one's normal health functions and the appearance of new phenomena of a distressing nature. This data set includes two GHQ scores, the GHQ score and the corrected GHQ score

224 participants

Data Collection Methods

GHQ was administered by paper-and-pencil on the first clinic evaluation day. The scores were derived from the raw responses later.
