Introduction

This report presents 1990 birth and fertility rates for the United States, geographic divisions, and States. There are demographic as well as socioeconomic and behavioral factors that contribute to State variations in these rates. Some demographic factors contributing to differences among States are the age, sex, marital status, and racial composition of the resident populations. In addition to these demographic factors, differences in pregnancy and abortion rates contribute to State variations in birth and fertility rates; these differences as they affect rates for teenagers have been addressed in previous reports (1,2).

Although summary data through 1992 have been published in other reports (3,4) detailed rates by State and for Hispanic subgroups can only be computed in census years. The 1990 decennial census contains information for each State on the age, sex, marital status, race, and Hispanic origin of its residents so rates can be computed for each of these subgroups. The measures of fertility used in this report are the crude birth rate, general fertility rate, age-specific birth rate, total fertility rate, and birth rate by live-birth order (for definitions, see "Measures of fertility"). Birth and fertility rates for States and geographic divisions for 1980 and for States, geographic divisions, and Standard Metropolitan Statistical Areas for the 1970 census period have been published in earlier reports (5,6).

Since 1978 the birth certificates of a number of States have requested information on parents' ethnic origin. Birth and fertility rates for the Hispanic population for the 22 States that reported this information in 1980 have been published (5). After the U.S. Standard Certificate of Live Birth was revised in 1989, more States added items on parents' ethnic origin to their certificates. This increased the total number to 48 States

and the District of Columbia in 1990; only New Hampshire and Oklahoma did not include these items. The reporting States accounted for 99.6 percent of the Hispanic-origin population in the United States in 1990 (7). A comprehensive analysis of the fertility of the major Hispanic-origin groups is presented elsewhere (8,9).

Beginning with 1989 data, the National Center for Health Statistics tabulated its birth data primarily by race of mother rather than by race of child. The reasons for this change are discussed in detail in the section "Race and Hispanic origin." This report presents numbers and birth rates tabulated by the race of the mother for 1990.

Tables 1–4 contain 1990 data by race of mother for the United States, each geographic division, and State. Table 1 contains the number of live births, birth rates, fertility rates, and total fertility rates. Table 2 contains birth rates for 5-year age groups as well as subgroups 15–17 and 18–19 years, and the total fertility rate. Table 3 contains birth rates by live-birth order. Birth rates for unmarried mothers for 5-year age groups and subgroups 15–17 and 18–19 are shown in table 4.

Tables 5–8 contain data for the Hispanic-origin population and by race of mother for the non-Hispanic population comparable to the data in tables 1–4. Table 5 includes each of the 48 States and the District of Columbia that reported information on ethnicity in 1990. Tables 6–8, which show rates for more detailed demographic subgroups, only include those States with 1,000 or more Hispanic-origin births in 1990.

U.S. birth and fertility rates for American Indian and Asian or Pacific Islander women have been published (9,10). These population groups are relatively small and tend to be highly concentrated geographically. Therefore, it is possible to compute meaningful rates for only a few States. Because the focus of this report is the presentation of birth rates by State, rates for these population groups are not presented.

Measures of fertility

Crude birth rate

This measure, often called the birth rate, relates the number of births to the total population residing in the area. It is expressed as the total number of live births per 1,000 population, without regard to the age or sex distribution of the population. For example, the birth rate of 14.1 in Maine (table 1) means that for every 1,000 residents of that State, there were 14.1 births in 1990.

The chief use of the birth rate is to indicate the contribution of births to the growth of the population of an area. It is limited as an analytical tool when comparing fertility levels between areas because these comparisons are affected by differences in the demographic composition of the populations. Measures of fertility that take into account such differences from one population to another are more useful for most interarea and intergroup comparisons of fertility.

General fertility rate

Often termed the fertility rate, this is one of the most common measures of fertility. It relates the total number of births in an area to the population of women most at risk of childbearing—those 15–44 years of age. The general fertility rate is the number of live births per 1,000 women of this age group. For example, the fertility rate of 60.5 in Maine (table 1) indicates that in 1990 there were 60.5 births per 1,000 women 15–44 years of age residing in that State.

The fertility rate controls for differences among areas in the proportion of women of childbearing age in the population. However, differences in the age distribution within the childbearing years can influence the level of this rate, just as differences in the age-sex composition of the total population can affect the crude birth rate.

Age-specific birth rate

This rate relates the number of births to mothers of a given age to the female population of that age. In this report the rates are expressed as the number of births to mothers in a particular age group per 1,000 women in that age group. For example, the rate of 43.0 for women 15–19 years of age in Maine (table 2) means that in 1990 there were 43.0 births per 1,000 women 15–19 years of age residing in Maine. Birth

rates for women 15–17 and 18–19 years of age are computed as well as rates for 5-year age groups 10–14 through 45–49 years.

Total fertility rate

This measure summarizes a set of age-specific birth rates for the entire childbearing span. The total fertility rate is computed as the sum of the age-specific birth rates for 5-year age groups 10–14 through 45–49 each multiplied by 5. It is an age-adjusted rate because it is based on the assumption that there are the same number of women (1,000) in each 5-year age group. Therefore, it controls for differences between areas in the distribution of women within the childbearing years. The 1990 total fertility rate for a specified area indicates the number of children 1,000 women would bear if they experienced the 1990 age-specific birth rates throughout their childbearing period (10–49 years). For example, the rate of 1,820.0 for Maine (table 2) means that if 1,000 women were to have the same birth rate at each 5-year age period that was observed for Maine residents in 1990, they would bear a total of 1,820 children by the time they reached the end of their childbearing years. Total fertility rates were only computed for subgroups that had at least 1,000 births and 2,500 women 15–44 years of age in the population.

The total fertility rate reflects the combined childbearing experience of women of all ages in a given year. It therefore can be interpreted as representing the implications of current levels of fertility for completed family size. The total fertility rate also can be used to judge if replacement level fertility has been reached. This is the level of fertility required for a population to exactly replace itself under projected mortality rates and in the absence of migration. In the United States this level is about 2,110 (11). A total fertility rate of less than 2,110 for an area is an indication that current fertility is below the level needed for long-term replacement.

Order-specific birth rate

In addition to age of the mother, a characteristic useful for analyzing fertility is the order of birth of the child. The first birth rate, for example, provides a measure of the rate of family formation. Live-birth order refers to the number of children born alive to the mother, including the present birth. The order-specific birth rate for an area relates the number of

births of a given live-birth order to the number of women 15–44 years of age residing in the area.

Note that the sum of the order-specific rates equals the general fertility rate. When computing order-specific rates,

births of unknown order are proportionately distributed according to births of known order. The rate of 26.0 for first births in Maine (table 3) means that there were 26.0 first births for every 1,000 women 15–44 years of age residing in that State.

Sources of data

Births

Birth data used to compute rates are based on information obtained from the birth certificates of the 50 States and the District of Columbia.

In 1990 marital status for mothers in 44 States and the District of Columbia was derived directly from the reported marital status on the birth certificates; for the remaining 6 States that did not request this information on the birth certificate (California, Connecticut, Michigan, Nevada, New York, and Texas) marital status was inferred from a comparison of the child's and parents' surnames. A detailed explanation and an evaluation of this procedure are presented in another report (12).

Population bases

Birth and fertility rates for the United States and individual States are based on the total resident populations of the respective areas. Two possible additional influences on the rates are the number of Armed Forces and the number of students residing in the area. The populations for an area exclude the Armed Forces abroad but include the Armed Forces stationed in the area. Students attending college are also considered residents of the area in which they attend school. Crude birth rates would tend to be lowered for areas with large numbers of Armed Forces or students. Fertility rates would also tend to be lowered to some extent for areas with large numbers of students.

The 1990 total population and populations of women 15–44 years of age by race for the United States, each geographic division, and State are shown in table 9. These population data by race were modified by the U.S. Bureau of the Census to allocate the race for the substantial number of persons (9.8 million or 3.9 percent out of 248.7 million total population) who did not specify a racial group; persons of unknown race were classified as White, Black, American Indian (including Eskimo and Aleut), and Asian or Pacific Islander. The populations were also modified by age to reflect age as of the census reference date. The reasons for modification and procedures are described in a U.S. Bureau of the Census report (7).

For the 48 States and the District of Columbia that reported information on ethnicity in 1990, table 10 contains the total population and the population of women 15–44 years

of age by Hispanic origin for the Hispanic-origin population and by race for the non-Hispanic population.

Race and Hispanic origin

The racial classification used in this report is that of the mother, a change from the 1980 report which showed data classified by the race of the child. In 1988 and prior years births were tabulated by the race of the child, which was determined from the race(s) of the parents as entered on the birth certificate; this procedure is described in another report (13).

Beginning with the 1989 data year, NCHS has tabulated its birth data primarily by race of the mother. The most important factor influencing the decision to tabulate births by race of the mother was the 1989 revision of the birth certificate. This revision included many more health questions that were directly associated with the mother (for example, method of delivery, medical risk factors for this pregnancy, tobacco and alcohol use during pregnancy, and maternal weight gain). Additionally, many of the other data items that have been on the birth certificate for more than two decades also relate directly to the mother, for example, educational level and receipt of prenatal care. In all these instances, it is more appropriate to tabulate births by the mother's race.

A second factor was the increasing incidence of interracial parentage. In 1990, 3.5 percent of births were to parents of difference races compared with just 1.3 percent in 1970. In general the majority of the interracial births were to white mothers and fathers of another race. There are two major consequences of the increasing interracial parentage. The first is the effect on birth rates by race. The number of white births under the pre-1989 procedures had been arbitrarily limited to infants whose parents were both white (or one parent white if only one parent's race was reported). At the same time, the number of births of other races had been arbitrarily increased to include all births to white mothers and fathers of other races. Thus, if race of mother had been used, birth rates per 1,000 white women in a given age group would have been higher while comparable rates for black women and women of other races would have been lower.

The second consequence of increasing interracial parentage is its impact on the racial differentials in various characteristics of births, particularly in cases where there is generally a large racial disparity, such as the incidence of nonmarital childbearing. In this instance the racial differential is smaller

when the data are tabulated by race of child rather than by race of mother. The same effect has been noted for characteristics such as low birthweight, preterm births, late or no prenatal care, and low educational attainment of mother.

The third factor influencing the decision to tabulate by race of mother was the growing proportion of births with the race of the father not stated, 15 percent in 1990 compared with 7 percent in 1968. This reflects the increase in the proportion of births to unmarried women; in many such cases no information is reported on the father. For these cases, births are assigned the race of the mother because there is no alternative. Tabulating births by race of mother provides for a more uniform approach, rather than a necessarily arbitrary combination of parental races. This topic is examined in greater detail in two papers (14,15).

In the computation of birth and fertility rates by Hispanic origin, births are classified by the origin of the mother as

reported on the birth certificate. Births with unknown origin of the mother (about 1 percent in 1990) are included with non-Hispanic births; origin has been imputed for the population that did not indicate a specific origin in the 1990 census. Thus, rates for the Hispanic population are underestimates of the true rates to the extent that some births with unknown origin are actually births to Hispanic mothers. However, the effect on the rates is believed to be small.

Birth and fertility rates shown for the Mexican population in New Mexico are based on births to Mexican and "other" Hispanic women combined and on combined Mexican and "other" Hispanic population. It was necessary to compute a combined rate because it appeared that these two groups were not reported consistently on the birth certificate and in the 1990 census.
