I would like to suggest that the Zadroga Bill include ptsd and depression in the VCF portion of the bill. Please consider the following when implementing it's final policies.

- 1. The WTC Monitoring program acknowledges, treats and refers individuals based entirely upon a mental health injury. The Zadroga Bill identifies mental injuries as a causality of the attacks of September 11th.
- 2. The NYS WTC Presumption Bill identifies PTSD and Depression as a compensative injury directly related to the attacks at the WTC.
- 3. The SSA makes no distinction in regard to mental and physical injury

I would like that NIOSH Committee on the Zadroga Bill institute a rule that does not treats those with mental injury any different than those with physical injury. I think that such consideration is necessary in the interest of a fair and equal treatment for all that suffer as a result of the tragedies of September 11th.
