 All personnel that worked in any area at Sandia National Laboratories in Albuquerque, New Mexico for the period from January 1, 1963 through May 21, 2011



Existing worker class 1

- SEC00162 (2011)
- All employees of the Department of Energy, its predecessor agencies, and its contractors and subcontractors who worked in any area at Sandia National Laboratories in Albuquerque, New Mexico, from January 1, 1949, through December 31, 1962



Existing worker class 2

- SEC00188 (2012)
- All employees of the Department of Energy, its predecessor agencies, and its contractors and subcontractors who worked in any area at Sandia National Laboratories in Albuquerque, New Mexico, from January 1, 1963, through December 31, 1994



Addendum status

- NIOSH addendum to SEC00188 by March 2018
- Addendum will evaluate internal monitoring program completeness, sufficiency
- 1995 through May 21, 2011 worker population



Research

 Evaluation of internal and external assessments of the Radiological Program, and a review of monitoring data completeness, sufficiency, and compliance with rules



Research cont.

- 7 data capture efforts at site since last SEC designation (20 trips total)
- 761 relevant documents captured and reviewed since last SEC designation (4,071 total documents)
- 17 interviews with 15 people
