    - b. Policy No. 16740-G, as amended, Part I (Salaried) and Part II (Hourly), issued by Metropolitan Life Insurance Company.

Premium costs allowable hereunder shall be limited to the cost of the total premiums required by the terms of the respective agreements less applicable credits and refunds, and less amounts contributed by participating employees in accordance with Schedule VIII of this Appendix A.

Allowable costs for the contractor's share of the premiums for a retired employee who was employed at the Rocky Flats Plant for a period of less than five years shall be that portion of the contractor's share paid for such employee which the employee's years of service with the contractor at the Rocky Flats Plant bear to the total years of service as an employee of the contractor."
